Budget Christmas Cooking (Dessert)



Gingerbread Trifle (serves 10)

Method

1. Half the heavy whipping cream into two bowls. Add the caramel sauce to one bowl and whisk until it's whipped. In the second bowl, add sour cream and icing sugar and whisk until it's whipped.
2. Cut the cake into 2cm-thick slices, then layer one-third of slices over the bottom of a trifle dish. Drizzle this with one-third of the brandy (optional), sprinkle over one-third of cinnamon, then one-quarter of the gingerbread crumbs.
3. Top this with one-third of the caramel whipped cream, then one-third of the other whipped cream mixture. Repeat this layering process twice, then finish with the remaining crumbs.

Show it off, and enjoy!

Ingredients

- 900ml heavy whipping cream
- 330g caramel sauce
- 250g sour cream
- 40g icing sugar (sifted)
- 800g gingerbread cake
- 90ml marsala or brandy (optional)
- 1 and 1/2 tsp. cinnamon
- 200g gingerbread OR
gingernut biscuits - crumbled




